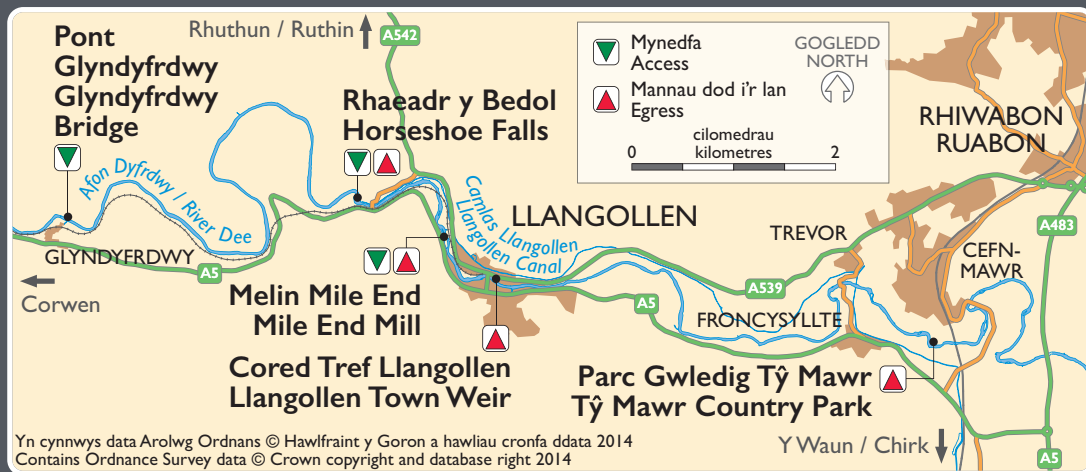


CROESO | WELCOME TO BONT GLYNDYFRDWY | GLYNDYFRDWY BRIDGE



MYNEDFA I GANŴWYR

Caniateir padlo os ydi lefel y dŵr yn cyrraedd o leiaf tri throedfedd (Dŵr Uchel) ar fedrydd dyfnder Coed y Glyn am 8yb, mae hyn yn berthnasol drwy'r flwyddyn.

Rhwng Ebrill y 1af ac Awst y 30ain, caniateir padlo ar ddydd Mercher a dydd Sadwrn beth bynnag ydi uchder y dŵr.

Caiff canŵwyr gychwyn rhwng 10yb (9.30yb i Hyfforddwr Canŵio) a 12.30yp, nid ydi'r amser yma'n amrywio. Cofiwch fod yn is i lawr na Groeslwyd erbyn 1.30yp a dod i'r lan yng Nghored Tref Llangollen erbyn 3yp.

Ni chaniateir tiwbiau na rafftau (heblaw am 'duckies').
Mwyafrif o ddau berson ymhob canŵ/'duckie'.

Mae'r rheolau ynghylch ymarfer canŵio/caiacio ar wahân i'r daflen yma.

MANNAU DOD I'R LAN

Rhaeadr y Bedol - ochr chwith yr afon (ochr y gamlas).

Melin Mile End – ochr dde yr afon (ochr ganol y canŵ).

Cored Tref Llangollen – 200 llath yn is lawr yr afon ar ôl y bont, ar ochr chwith yr afon (grisiau cyfagos i Dafarn Ponsonby).

Parc Gwledig Tŷ Mawr - 6 milltir yn is na Phont Llangollen, ar ochr chwith yr afon (ar yr amod bod uchder yr afon yn dri throedfedd ar y medrydd dyfnder am 8yb).

ACCESS POINT FOR CANOES

Paddling is allowed if the water level is at least 3ft (High Water) in the Coed Y Glyn gauge at 8am, at any time of the year.

Between 1st April and 30th August, paddling is allowed on Wednesdays and Saturdays irrespective of water height.

In all cases, launching is between 10am (9.30am for Commercial Operators) and 12.30pm. Please be downstream of Groeslwyd by 1.30pm and vacate the water by 3pm at Llangollen Town Weir.

No tubes or rafts allowed (other than duckies).
Max 2 persons per canoe/duckie.

Please see separate rules regarding canoe/kayak practice.

EGRESS POINTS

Horseshoe Falls - river left (canal side).

Mile End Mill – river right (canoe centre side).

Llangollen Town Weir – 200 yards downstream of bridge, river left (adjacent steps to Ponsonby Arms).

Tŷ Mawr Country Park - 6 miles downstream of Llangollen bridge, river left (subject to river height of 3ft on the gauge at 8am).
